<p>Priority: Randallstown High School's economically disadvantaged and special education students are under-performing as evidenced by the multiple standardized assessment data. College Career Readiness scores aligned to student literacy performance benchmarks must improve.</p>

<p>Goal: By 2020, the SAT ERBW mean score for all students will increase from 443 to 450.</p>	<p>Goal: By 2020, the SAT EBRW mean score for special education students will increase from 363 to 370.</p>
<p>Instructional Focus: Teachers will analyze reading data to monitor student learning in order to inform their instructional decisions such as forming targeted small group instruction, lesson pacing, content for reviewing or reteaching, and supplemental intervention needs.</p>	<p>Instructional Focus: Teachers will provide students who have IEPs (with document reading challenges) daily and supplemental reading intervention, with a focus on instruction in reading, vocabulary acquisition, and spelling unknown words.</p>

<p>Priority: As a result of RHS students not meeting proficiency benchmarks in mathematics, intentional planning and implementation of responsive instruction is required to address performance on the various standardized assessments.</p>

<p>Goal: By 2020, SAT math mean score for all students will increase from 409 to 416.</p>	<p>Goal: By 2020, SAT math mean score for special education students will increase from 345 to 350.</p>
<p>Instructional Focus: Teachers will implement explicit, systematic instruction with a focus on assessing student understanding throughout the lesson and adjusting instruction as needed.</p>	<p>Instructional Focus: Teachers will instruct students how to intentionally choose from alternative algebraic strategies when solving problems (i.e. verbally, numerically, graphically/geometrically, and algebraically).</p>

<p>Priority: Though RHS's student attendance rate is steadily increasing, the total number of chronically absent students must continue to decrease.</p>

<p>Goal: Reduce chronic absenteeism of all students by 3% - from 30% to 27%</p>	<p>Goal: Increase attendance of FARMs population by 1.5% - from 90.5% to 92%</p>
